#### WHAT YOUR CHILD WILL NEED:

Students will **need warm winter clothing including snow pants, gloves/mitts, winter boots, water bottle and lunch/snack**. Please be aware the school **will not** be held responsible for lost money.

**Helmets are mandatory** for all students who choose to ski or snowboard and are provided by Apex.

**Liability waivers:** All ski/snowboarding students (chaperones) will receive a daily lift pass and that will act as their waiver and liability release. All tubing students will receive a tubing ticket that goes on the student, (or chaperone) and this acts as their waiver and liability release. No further forms are required at APEX.
