  - 1. This summer we will create a pamphlet/flyer to be passed out in student packages at the beginning of the school year/at this event so that parents can see where all of our fundraising dollars have gone and what PAC is paying for (vs. the school)

### • Hot lunches: next year-

- i. This is a school initiative, not PAC
- ii. However, we would like to do some of our own research and get some numbers and options we know our kids would eat
  - 1. Which PAC member would like to take this on?
- iii. <u>PIZZA DAYS</u> it was brought to the attention of PAC that the owners of Bullies Pizza are upset we did not do Pizza Days with them this year and they would like to know why

- 1. *Answer* it was 1 volunteer taking this on (collecting forms, sorting money, ordering, and delivering). Way too much for 1 person.
  - There were also complaints brought to this volunteer that pizza sizes were not standard/equal. This was also brought to the attention of the owners, but not fixed.

#### 2. Possible Remedies -

- Do we create a PAC committee, so more then 1 person is running this initiative. Would order X# of pizzas, rather then exact slices ordered.
- OR Perhaps next year they can work with the school and be part of hot lunch days

## • Student Fees (aka Field trip money) concerns -

- i. Essentially we would like some answers as to what school pays for
  - 1. Student fee forms from the beginning of the year say students receive 1 fall/winter and 1 spring/summer activity through fees parents pay. We're concerned about where that money went so that students did not getting swimming lessons this year.
- ii. What we're asking the school for a breakdown of students fees and what that money got spent on. What did the school pay for this year?
  - 1. Do the fees go into a school pot, or directly to the class our child is in?
  - 2. How does bussing work for field trips? Does the money come out of fees, or from their transportation budget
- iii. We would like see the answers/ budget breakdown for our first meeting in September.
